## Correio Encryption Upgrade

Correio AVS version 2.1.12 upgrades the encryption used by the USPS AMS API from SHA-1 to SHA-256 technology. This version of the Correio AVS software will only work with USPS databases that are also encrypted with SHA-256 technology. CUTEK will begin distributing USPS databases that use SHA-256 technology with the May, 2017, database update, available via the Correio Downloader.

There are no interface changes in this new version of the Correio AVS software. It is completely backwards-compatible with existing PowerOn specfiles designed to work with Correio AVS version 2.1.11.

You may continue to use Correio AVS version 2.1.11 with databases up to and including the March, 2017, database. The March, 2017, database will expire on June 28, 2017, so you must upgrade to Correio AVS version 2.1.12 before that date.

## Correio Server Upgrade Instructions

The upgrade to Correio AVS version 2.1.12 is performed entirely on your Correio server.

1. Use Correio Downloader to download the latest USPS database to a new folder, following your usual procedure.
2. When the download finishes, dismiss the registry error message and *do not* update your Correio settings to point to the new folder (yet).
3. Run CorreioShell as administrator and click File, Stop AVS Service to stop Correio.
4. Close CorreioShell.
5. Download the new installer (refer to your email for download location).

6. Run the new installer; the welcome screen will display:



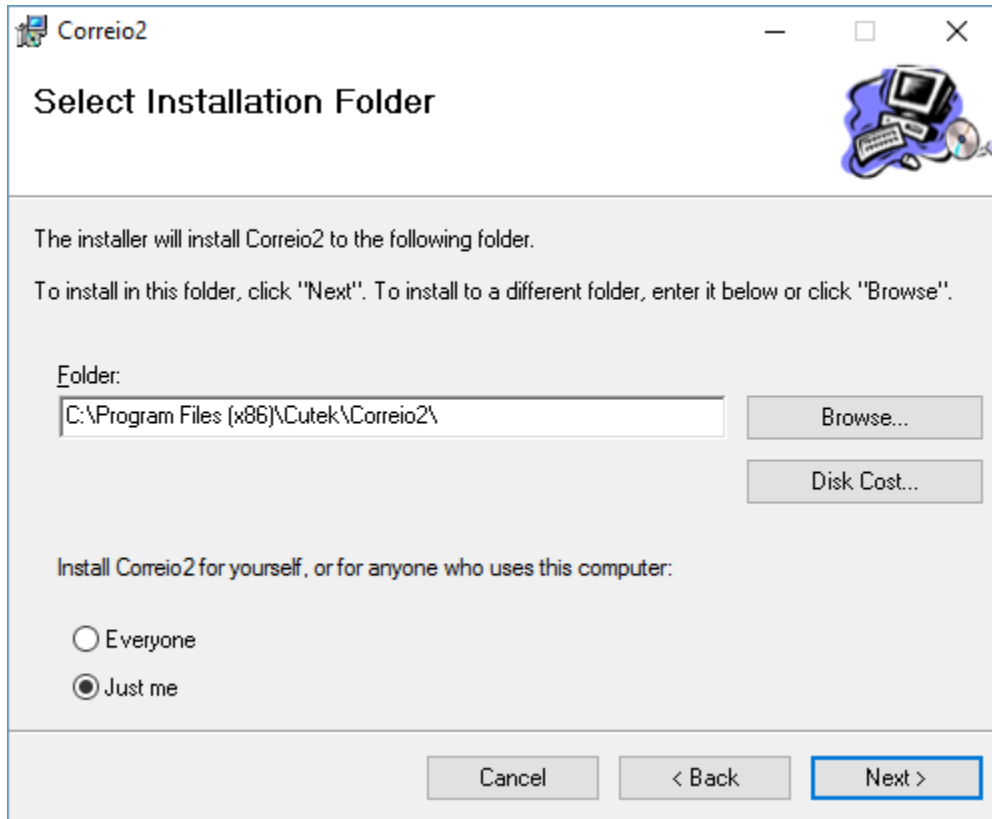

7. Click Next to display the Select Installation Folder screen:



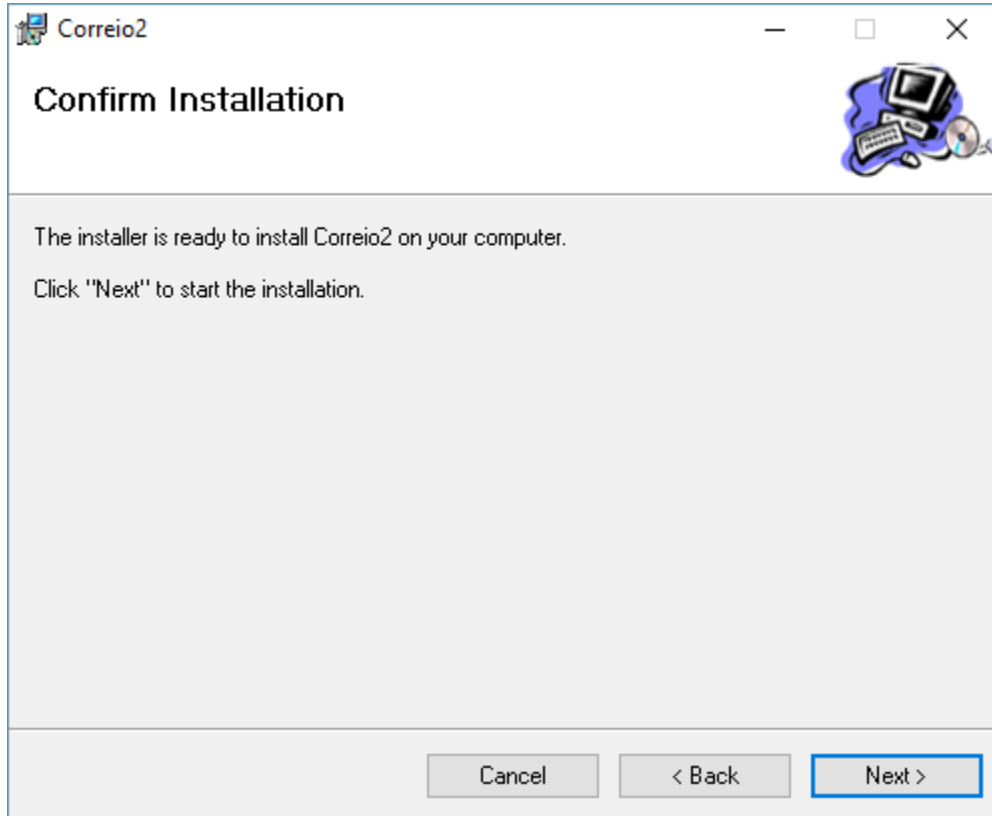

8. Take the defaults and click Next to display the Confirmation screen. (You should install the new version on top of the existing version.)



9. Click Next to install Correio. The Installation Complete screen will display and then the Correio AVS window and, possibly, the Settings dialog will display. (If the User Access Control asks you

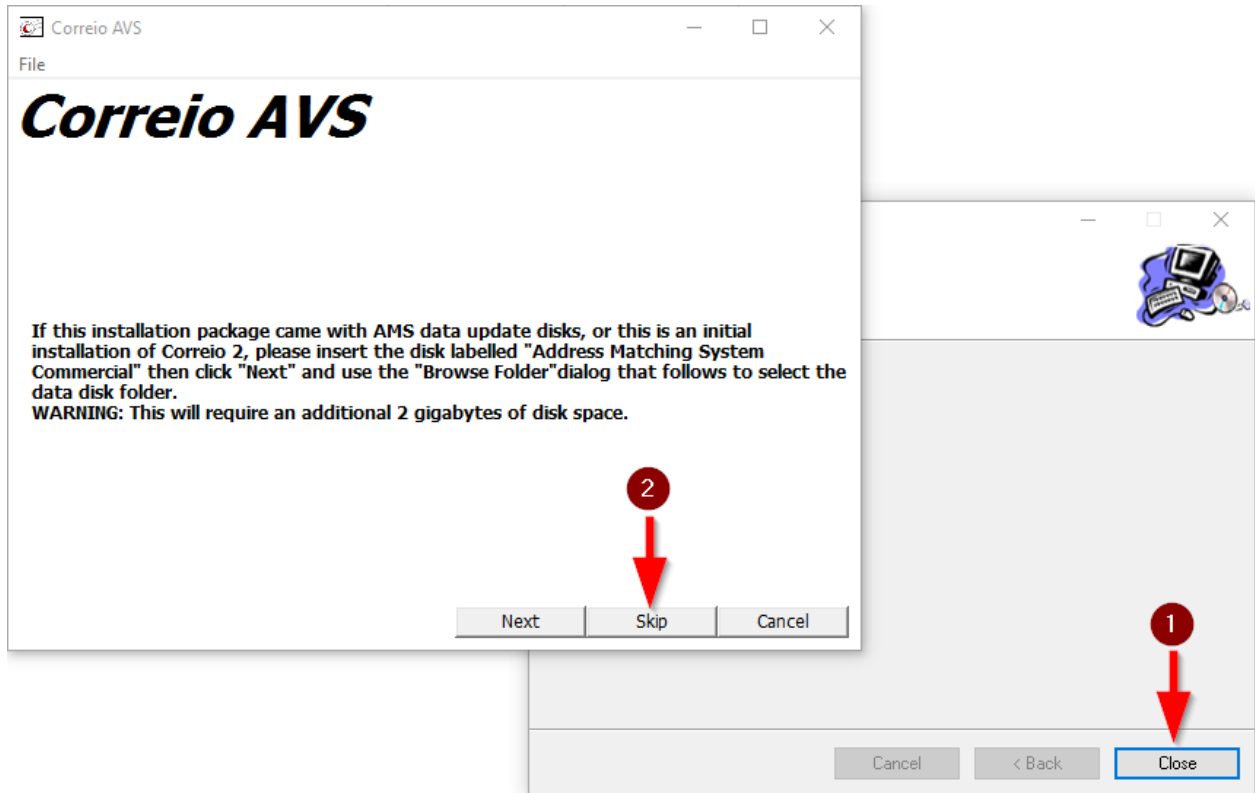

for permission to install, answer Yes.)



10. Click Close on the Installation Complete screen (may be in the background). **1**
11. If the Settings window has already popped up, change the USPS AMS Data Directory setting to point to the folder where you downloaded the new USPS database in step 1. Click OK to commit the change.
12. Click Skip on the Correio AVS windows. **2**
13. If the Settings window did not display automatically, click File, Settings, on the Correio AVS windows and change the USPS AMS Data Directory setting to point to the folder where you downloaded the new USPS database in step 1. Click OK to commit the change.
14. Correio should restart automatically. If the screen reads, "Status: The service has not been started.", click File, Start AVS Service.

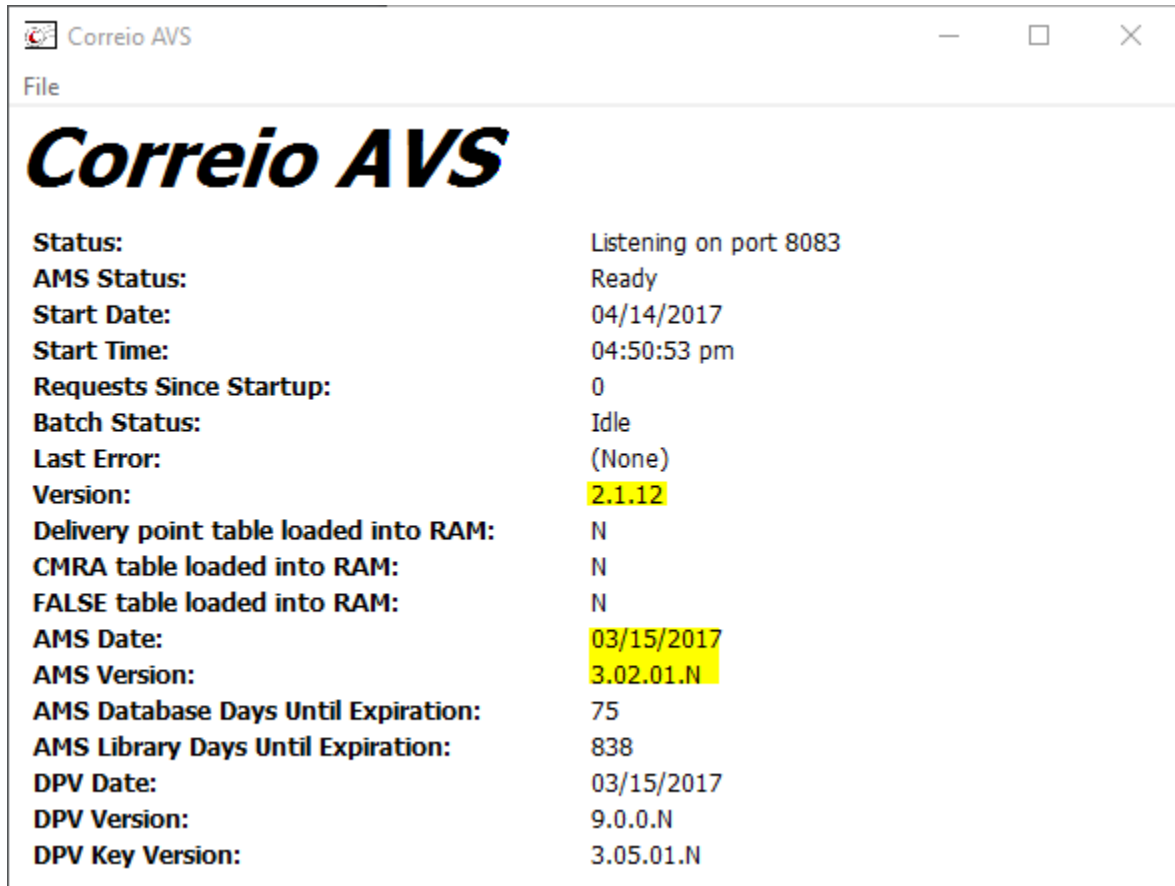

15. The Correio AVS screen should look similar to the following:



16. Verify that the **Version** displays 2.1.12, the **AMS Date** reflects the month and year of the database you downloaded, and that the **AMS Version** is 3.02.01.N.
